School meal charges from 1st April 2019- Price increase

Rotherham meals service have experienced a number of increases in expenditure over the last 2 years which they have avoided passing on to parents which has enabled a price freeze for over 2 years. Unfortunately the living wages cost, food price rises and increases in transport costs has resulted in a requirement to increase the charge to for a meal by 5p to £2.10 from 1st April 2019.

We believe this price still represents exceptional value for a healthy two course freshly prepared meal.
