COVID update

Following updated guidance from the DfE, we have made a number of changes to our Risk Assessment and you will be able to find this on the school website using the following link.

One significant change is to the requirements for children age 5 upwards and adults identified as a close contact. New guidance is as follows:

From Tuesday 14 December, people who are fully vaccinated and identified as a contact of someone with COVID-19 – whether Omicron or not – should take an NHS rapid lateral flow test every day for 7 days to help slow the spread of COVID-19.

If they test negative, they can continue to attend their education setting. If they test positive, they should self-isolate and <u>order a PCR test</u> to confirm the result. If the PCR is positive, they must self-isolate for 10 days.

School continues to maintain the four main control measures of good hygiene, appropriate cleaning regime, good ventilation and following Public Health advice.

Updated guidance from the DfE also states:

Schools are strongly encouraged to ask parents and other visitors to take a lateral flow device (LFD) test before entering the school.

Therefore, while **we will <u>not</u>** ask for evidence of a negative LFD test, we would ask that parents/ carers test before attending meetings in school.

Testing kits are free and available in the following ways:

- **LFD Direct:** You can order a box of tests online or through 119, which will be delivered to your home. You can order your lateral flow test on the GOV.UK website.
- Pharmacy collect: You can collect free lateral flow tests to use at home from a participating pharmacy. Use <u>NHS England's site finder</u> to find pharmacies near you that offer the service. You will need to use a collect code when you pick up your tests from pharmacies. Get your code at https://gov.uk/get-collect-code

St. Clare's MAT update

After the Christmas break we are expecting a letter from the Diocese of Hallam with further information regarding the move to academy status. The St. Clare MAT has appointed a CEO, Steve Davis and a CFO, Adnan Bashir. The Diocese has received notification that the voluntary aided schools within the Diocese have been given permission by the Regional Schools Commissioner to formally pursue academy status and join their respective Catholic MAT.

Uniform

Children should wear full school uniform every day except on Forest School and PE days when outdoor PE kit should be worn. School uniform is black or grey trousers/skirt/shorts, white polo shirt and royal blue jumper/cardigan/sweatshirt, black or grey socks or tights and plain black shoes or trainers.

Outdoor PE kit is black or navy tracksuit bottoms, plain white teeshirt and royal blue jumper/cardigan/sweatshirt. Children may choose to wear royal blue Forest School badged tops on Forest School/PE days.

Long hair should be fastened back. No jewellery, nail polish or make up should be worn with the exception of one pair of small stud earrings and a watch (not smartwatch) or fitbit. Children must be able to remove earrings themselves for PE.
