As you aware the National Education Union (NEU) has announced national and regional strike action for teachers in England on the following dates:

- Wednesday 15th March 2023
- Thursday 16th March 2023

Teachers who are members of the NEU are not required to inform their schools if they are taking part in strike action beforehand. In theory, they could just be absent on the day, with no prior warning. This makes it extremely difficult to have an accurate picture of staffing levels for the days of industrial action.

It is very important that pupils arrive at school in time for the start of the day.

The following information is from our Attendance Policy which can be found on the school website: The register is taken at 8.45 am. Pupils arriving after this time must enter school by the main entrance and report to Reception where their name and the reason for lateness will be recorded. Children arriving after this time will miss important information given by the teacher and part of the first task of the day. This can also be disruptive to other pupils. The register will close 30 minutes after the register has been taken (DfE May 2022). Pupils arriving after the register has closed will be marked as late after registration (Code 'U') and this will count as an unauthorised absence. Frequent lateness after the register has closed (Code 'U') will be discussed with parents and could provide grounds for prosecution or a Fixed Penalty Notice.
